PLANNING APPPLICATON (16/00998/FULL) Application for the storage of up to 70,200 litres of LPG at land and buildings at NGR 285916 112901 Tollgate Farm, Nomansland

A Lengthy discussion took place.

Proposal: Mr Berry proposed and Mr Lake seconded approval of this application and the meeting unanimously agreed with the comments below:

- Why were these storage tanks not shown in the original planning application?
- The storage tanks are already in place before this planning application has been decided!
- In accordance with the original planning application for replacement chicken houses, there was a proposal for photovoltaic panels to be placed on some of the chicken houses roofs in line with a carbon reduction strategy. Does this still apply with these proposed storage tanks?
- It is understood that the HSE is involved with approval of this application and this must be a condition of granting this application.

TAP FUND

The clerk stated that she had looked into the purchase of a defibrillator (cost approx. £1,200 -£1,800) with some funding being applied for from the TAP Fund. Discussion took place about whether the Young Farmers would be interested in managing a defibrillator that could be possibly housed in the telephone kiosk next to the Cruwys Arms, but would need constant checking. Also, further funding will probably be needed over and above what the TAP Fund could provide and would the Young Farmers be prepared to raise the require amount.

The clerk will contact the Young Farmers and report back.

MINUTE BOOK

The clerk reported that the Minute Book used to hold all the parish council's typed minutes is nearly full and a new book is needed. The cost of a new book is £149.69 (£124.74 + VAT £24.95).

Proposal: Mr Lake proposed and Mrs Mitchell seconded the purchase of a new book and the meeting unanimously agreed. The clerk was asked to order a new book.
