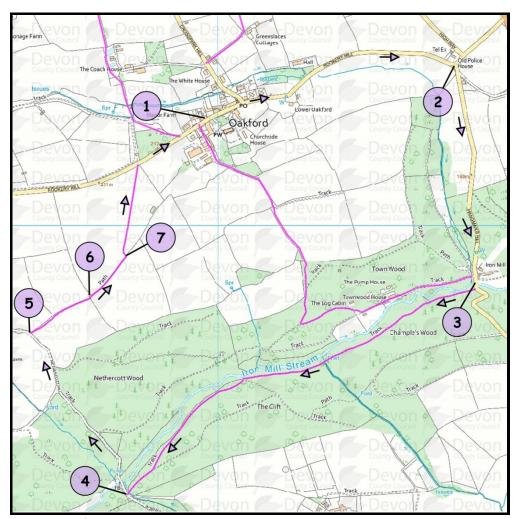
Walk 2

Time 50 minutes Distance 4km (2.5 miles)

This is a relatively easy walk, with a long flat section of well-surfaced track along the far side of **Iron Mill Stream**. Inevitably, there are also steep sections, down a guiet road and back up on a stony track.

- On coming out of the Red Lion 1 turn left and walk through the village. About half a mile out of the village you reach Stuckeridge Cross

- 2. Turn right and go down a steep hill.
- 3. At the bottom of the hill cross the bridge 3 and turn immediately right, where it is signed footpath. Walk along the path, keeping the **Iron**Mill Stream on your right. At the end of the path turn right 4.
- 4. Go over the footbridge and carry on up the hill.
- 5. Near the top is a footpath sign into a field **(5)**, turn right through the gate. Go through the field, keeping the hedge on your left.
- 6. Go through the next gate **6** and into the next field. About three quarters of the way through the field is a gate on your left **7**.
- 7. Go through it and then diagonally right across the field, where you will find a kissing gate on to the road. Go through this gate and turn right down the hill until you get back to the **Red Lion**.



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
