## Minutes of the 158th meeting of the Parish Council, held on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2016 at 7.30.

Matters Arising:-

PC Website: BC & RC had a 3 hour session on the website with only a little progress, more advice is being sought before another attempt is made, we are aware of the urgency to have it fully functioning.

Phone box: RC reported difficulty reaching the right department at BT to attend to the repairs, V.O'D noted she will clean it ASAP.

Finance report:-

RC submitted the accounts for the year ending 31/03/2016 showing income for the year of £1,207.43 and expenditure of £1,254.03 leaving a deficit of £46.60. The bank balance stood at £1,111.15.

Roland Smith kindly agreed to audit the accounts again.

New Business:-

The revised MDDC code of conduct was duly adopted.

RC was asked by the councillors to write to the Village Hall Committee to ask when the decorating will take place as it is overdue, having been estimated on the TAP fund application to take place in February or March. Also to ask the committee to send a representative to attend the next meeting.

BT broadband/ fibreoptic cabling. No specific progress although there is correspondence ongoing. The council decided to ask RC to write to BT, Mel Stride and Connecting Devon & Somerset to protest that small villages were being discriminated against.

It was agreed to send a donation of £100 to St Bartholomew's Church for cemetery upkeep.
