	 Retaining and enhancing the natural beauty of the Parish Rights of Way Local green space within the village of Silverton and hamlet of Ellerhayes Minimising flood risk
Built Environment policies	BE01 – BE02 (p26 - 30)
	Section 9 of the Plan shows the Village in its rural setting. The policies are to preserve Local Character, introduce Design Standards (BE01), and enhance its heritage assets (BE02)
Housing policies	HS01 - HS06 (p30 - 41)
	Section 10 of the Plan gives an historical overview of housing development in the Parish, outlines the proposed limits on new housing development and introduces possible alternative house-building initiatives. Housing Policies HS02, HS03 and HS04 refer to specific development sites.
Business and jobs policies	BJ01 – BJ03 (p42 - 45)
	Section 11 of the Plan, Business & Jobs, provides 3 Policies for employment: - BJ01 Roosters Employment site – support for continued use for light industrial or storage.
	BJ02 Super-fast connectivity – new premises to have a fibre optic connection on an open access basis.

	Infrastructure to be sensitively sited. BJ03 Home working – support for ancillary office or workshop use of residential premises.
