Grass removed and wild flower seed planted. Mix of annuals, biennials and perennials

Grass left to grow and rewild. Cut in mid to late summer and maybe a couple of other times. Cut grass and flowers removed for hay or compost

Different wildflower seed. Treated as per the other seeded section.

Wildflower Meadows are:

- Less work than short cut grass areas
- Beautiful during summer
- Known to be great for health and well being
- Support at least 8 times more wildlife
- Have declined by 97% since 1930's
