Once again, Ian and Jayne are raising funds for the vital work of Hospice UK. This is the national charity for vital hospice care and they support many of our local hospices.


Charities have all struggled during the pandemic and sadly, more and more people's lives have been touched with cancer, so their fundraising is even more important.
