

PARISH COUNCIL:

The Parish Council has asked Phil Bridges to investigate and report on the Openreach proposals for Fibre Broadband in the parishes served by the Lapford exchange. Here is his initial report:

FIBRE BROADBAND ROLLOUT PROPOSALS: UPDATE:



You may have heard rumblings that the majority of the "01363" Lapford telephone exchange numbers (*including Coldridge and Nymet Rowland*) have been pre-selected to be considered for a fibre broadband rollout by BT Openreach.

The Government have offered to fund this work to the tune of £4,500 per interested household with no direct financial contribution required from the consumer. There are useful gains for residents and businesses including a more reliable service and the potential for much faster speeds for those that need it. I have been doing some personal research on the rollout and speaking with Openreach to ensure that Coldridge parish residents' best interests are catered for, especially our elderly and frail residents.

I have left some Openreach leaflets at the Village Hall which will also be landing in your letter box in the next few weeks.

I've also researched some Frequently Asked Questions which can be viewed online -<u>https://bit.ly/3ZznCz2</u> or I am happy to drop a printed copy through your letterbox. Michelle Maidment of BT Openreach has offered to host a daytime meeting in Coldridge Village Hall in the near future to explain how the process could proceed. In the meantime, I am happy to answer residents' questions, by phone or email. Airband residents will be welcome to express an interest without committing themselves at this stage as the rollout is likely to be up to 12 months depending on how much work is required.

It is with great regret that we acknowledge the sudden death, last Tuesday (19^{th}), of Michael Thorne.

Mike was a small man of enormous energy, drive, wisdom and talent.

From a family farming background, he built a business from small beginnings into one of the leaders in its field in the South West. He was well-known as being a great enthusiast for everything Ferguson- or Massey-Ferguson-related; his knowledge of the marque knew absolutely no bounds. He was, in fact, a renowned and acknowledged authority on the subject, writing many books and articles, published world-wide.

Many might not realise how much he did for Coldridge, always in a quiet, unassuming way. Just one example: for many years his office kindly printed *The Coldridge Calendar* free of charge, every month, in the days before the internet and email, when we hand-delivered 150 printed paper copies round the parish every time!

He also brought many of the exhibits from his Lower Park tractor museum up to Coldridge Fete, many of us happily re-living our farming youth by volunteering to drive them up to the field and back again!

Mike was a good friend. He always stopped for a chat when I was out mowing the green; the conversation was always fascinating and usually wide-ranging.

An incredible chap. He will be greatly missed by us all. JWS

The winner will be the player with the biggest winnings (or smallest loss!) on the night.


