## Footpath 4: Brook Lane to Long Lane then over the Link Road towards Calverleigh (0.73 miles)

Leave Washfield down Brook Lane, opposite the Weeches. Passing Wynefreds on your right, this is one of the oldest houses in Washfield, and on down the lane to a field gate.

Go through the gate and go straight on keeping the hedge and then the fence on your right.

Under the trees and over a stile, follow the path then over another stile, across the bridge over the stream and through a kissing gate.

Carry on up the hill keeping the hedge on your right, cross the bridge over an old leat and through a gap in the hedge by some electricity poles and cross the field to a gate onto Long Lane.

Cross the lane and onto a driveway at Pound House after a few yards turn left through a gate and then right over a stile.

Take care crossing the A361, be patient and a gap in the traffic will happen!

Follow the track downhill past Harpridge and you will now be going into Calverleigh. Cross the water on a bridge to the right of the ford and continue up the track to join the B3221 Rackenford Road. The Rose and Crown at Calverleigh is about quarter of a mile to the left along this road.

## Footpath 4: From Calverleigh (over the Link Road) via Long Lane to Brook Lane (0.73 miles)

This path starts in Calverleigh leaving the Rackenford Road (B3221) opposite Palmershayes.

Follow the track, crossing the water over a bridge by the ford and up the hill into Washfield Parish.

Pass Harpridge and then take care crossing the A361, be patient and a gap in the traffic will happen!

Go over the stile, follow the path through a gate, turn right and after a few yards you will get to Long Lane by Pound House.

Go through a kissing gate opposite Pound House, cross the field to a gap in the hedge behind some electricity poles.

Cross the bridge over an old leat and then go downhill keeping the hedge on your left.

Go through the kissing gate, over the bridge and follow the path to a stile and then uphill under the trees to another stile.

Over the stile and continue uphill keeping the fence and hedge on your left. Go through the gate and follow the lane to the village, passing Wynefreds, one of the oldest houses in Washfield on your left.
