Don't miss the fun: Join Gardening Club for £15 per year. Non-members most welcome £3 per person.


WOMEN'S INSTITUTE:





Currently researchers are investigating the link between 5t Matthew's Church, Coldridge, Devon, and the mystery of The Missing Princes in the Tower. This lovely church contains a remarkable and very rare stained glass image of Edward V, one of the Princes, as well as other related artifacts. Each month an open lay is held when individuals or larger groups can enjoy a slide show and guided tour of the church. There is no entry charge for his but we are very pleased to receive donations towards the preservation of this nationally important historic church.
