October brings another wave of council business following a quieter summer. With the State of the District Debate concluded, attention shifts to housing, planning, and local government reform.

Community Safety

Mid Devon District Council is collaborating with Devon County Council to review security for leisure centres and car parks in the light of recent incidents.

Planning & Development

- We are moving from evidence-gathering to consultation: over the coming months, draft options for **Plan Mid Devon** will be published for public feedback.
- The Council is continuing to push for progress on **Junction 28 improvements**, a major transport priority for Yeo Ward.

Green Initiatives

- Later this autumn, new recycling trials (e.g. nappies, sanitary products) are planned following the success of the “pots & pans” trial.
- The roll-out of EV charging points across Mid Devon continues, alongside further tree-planting and habitat projects for increased biodiversity.
