Mid Devon District Council Report (Cllr Sandy Chenore)

Planning Update (NPPF)

The Government published a draft National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) in December 2025, currently open for consultation until March 2026. The changes aim to speed up planning decisions and support sustainable growth, with potential implications for rural parishes.

Mid Devon District Council is holding a Town & Parish Planning Event for councillors on **Wednesday 26 March 2026, 6:00–8:30pm**, to explain the changes and local impacts.

Support for Local Businesses

Significant Business Rates changes are coming in for 2026/27. An extra 15% relief for qualifying pubs and live music venues and around 53 Mid Devon businesses expected to benefit

Council Budget

After earlier warnings of large funding cuts, the Government has now confirmed a smaller reduction of 2.1% and full protection of business rates income.

This means Mid Devon District Council is now expecting to, set a balanced budget, keep Council Tax rises within limits and maintain existing service levels without using reserves

Leisure Services

To support affordability, leisure memberships will be frozen and pay-as-you-go prices will rise slightly in line with inflation

Waste, Recycling & Batteries

Green Enterprise Grants

The Green Enterprise Grant scheme returns from March 2026 until March 2028 (£20k per year), helping Mid Devon businesses reduce energy use and costs.

Village halls, parish halls and church halls will find it easier to apply in this round.
